National Glass Centre: Building a Collection

In less than 10 years National Glass Centre has built an international Studio Glass collection consisting of over 500 works. The collection tells our story through acquisitions, reflecting our temporary exhibition programme, the visiting artists, staff, students and graduates and collaborations between glass specialist and non-glass specialist artists. This talk tells the story of the second half of National Glass Centre's life through a reflection on the collection. The National Glass centre's recent arts programme has created opportunities for artists who are experts in glass making techniques and artists who are new to working in the medium.

Julia Stephenson has worked as Head of Arts at National Glass Centre for 12 years and has responsibility for exhibitions, collections and the public engagement programme.
